
Project Objectives

- 1. Gather evidence on how violence against women (VAW) is portrayed in the Cambodian media¹.
 - a. How frequently is VAW featured in the media?
 - b. How is VAW portrayed?
 - c. What are the strengths and weaknesses of current practices, in what ways are they complementing or undermining prevention efforts?
- 2. Develop feasible recommendations for key stakeholders (media industry, policy makers, development partners etc.) to address how the Cambodian media perceives and portrays violence.
 - a. What are short-term, critical practices that should be put in place immediately?
 - b. What are longer term training, codes of conducts, reporting standards that needs to be developed and adopted?


